And

CMR College of Engineering & Technology represented by its Principal here in after referred as 'Second Party', the institution which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors—in-office, administrators, and assigns.

1. About Youth for Seva (YFS)

Youth for Seva (YFS), founded in April 2007, is a nation-wide volunteering movement that inspires youth to volunteer, and provides them with meaningful opportunities to serve the community.

The goal of YFS is to support schools, destitute shelters, government hospitals and other organizations in the social sector through volunteers who can help them mitigate some of their shortcomings and challenges. Volunteering is made easy and customized to the individual's interests, time availability and skill sets.

YFS aims to create positive change agents in society, through the culture of volunteering.

2. About CMR College of Engineering & Technology (CMRCET)

CMR College of Engineering & Technology (CMRCET) is sponsored by MGR Educational society, which was established in 2002. The college is in a 10-acre serene environment which is lush green and free of pollution. All B.Tech programs are accredited by the NBA. A UGC Autonomous institute, it aims to be a premier academic institution striving continuously for excellence in technical education, research, and technological service to the nation.

NOW THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS

I. Scope of this MoU

A. Joint Responsibility.

Cooperation: Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their

respective operations within their related constituents. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.

General terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU.

The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

- 1. NMMS: The National Means cum Merit Scholarship Examination, also known as NMMS Exam, is sponsored by the Central Government. The examination is conducted by the local authority. To prevent the dropping out of economically backward students from school at class VIII and to encourage them to complete their education till the secondary stage, the exam seeks to identify meritorious students and fund their education expenses. CMR College of Engineering & Technology (CMRCET) shall encourage (50) students to volunteer for six (6) hours and one day in a week over a period of three (3) Months during every calendar year. Student Volunteers from CMRCET will attend training programs and later train children on the Mental Aptitude Test. (MAT) and Scholastic Aptitude Test. (SAT). Volunteers will support children, train, appear and crack the NMMS examination. Youth for Seva shall train the student volunteers on NMMS and assign nearby schools to render training by student volunteers to government or aided school children.
- 2. Volunteer Base and Credit Volunteering: A strong base of not less than hundred (100) student volunteers and a faculty mentor/supervisor under the Youth for Seva forum/club will be formed to render volunteering service. Student volunteers will participate in the YFS volunteer service activities as and when requested, based on the need for volunteer support required to address social issues or social developmental activities. Not less than hundred (100) students will take a credit volunteering program with Youth for Seva every calendar year.
- 3. NSS Activities, Volunteer Base and Internship: A strong base of not less than hundred (100) student volunteers and a faculty mentor/supervisor under the NSS or Youth for Seva forum/club will be formed to render volunteering service. Monthly volunteering activities will be planned and executed through NSS or Youth for Seva forum/club. Student volunteers will participate in the YFS volunteer service activities as and when requested, based on the need for volunteer support required to address social issues or social developmental activities. Not less than eighty (80) students will take up Credit Volunteering program with Youth for Seva during every calendar year.

- 4. Joint Publications & Exchange of Knowledge Resource: Joint publications of research articles, papers, books to develop research aptitude and to contribute to the world of knowledge. Share books, audio-videos, publications, reports and other teaching aids. Use each other's infrastructure such as auditorium, playground, and classrooms to host necessary events.
- 5. Community Oriented Development Activities: Youth for Seva will support CMR College of Engineering & Technology (CMRCET) towards addressing the local community needs in the area of Health, Education, Livelihood, and Environment. A list of eight various activities/interventions/events will be planned and executed during every academic calendar year.

B. Activities under the scope of CMR College of Engineering & Technology (CMRCET) (Second Party)

- 1. CMRCET will work as a knowledge partner and will be the hub for Research, TrainingDemonstration and Dissemination of information through the volunteers.
- 2. CMRCET will create a Youth for Seva volunteer base and provide students withinternship opportunities at youth for Seva.
- 3. CMRCET plan and execute community oriented development activities in the area of Health, Education, Livelihood, and Environment.

C. Activities under the scope of YFS (First Party)

- 1. Students from CMR College of Engineering & Technology (CMRCET) will play a key role in participating in the Skill Development, Volunteerism and community service based activities. YFS will mentor and initiate the students for involvement in these activities.
- 2. Youth for Seva will host student volunteers and internship program through its intervention programs in the local region.
- 3. Implementation partner community oriented development activities in the area of Health, Education, Livelihood, and Environment.

II. FINANCIAL COMMITMENTS.

There is no financial commitment on the part of the CMR College of Engineering & Technology (CMRCET) the First Party to take up any program mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately. Similarly, there are no financial or monetary commitments on the part of the YOUTH FOR SEVA- NGO the Second Party to take up any program mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

III. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Nothing contained in this MoU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property of the other Party.

IV. RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

It is expressly agreed that CMR College of Engineering & Technology (CMRCET) and YOUTH FOR SEVA- NGO are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Part.

V. AMENDMENTS TO THE MOU:

No amendment or modification of this MoU shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by both the parties or their authorized representatives and specifically stating the same to be an amendment of this MoU. The modifications / changes shall be effective from the date on which they are made / executed unless otherwise agreed to.

VI. ASSIGNMENT OF THE MOU

The rights or / and liabilities arising to any part of this MoU shall not be assigned except with the written consent of the other party and subject to such terms and conditions as may be agreed upon between the involved parties.

VII. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

Any divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MoU shall be resolved by arbitration between the parties as per the Arbitration Act, 1996. The place of the arbitration shall be at District Head Quarters of the First Party. This undertaking is to be construed in accordance with Indian Law with exclusive jurisdiction in the Courts of Hyderabad.

VIII. VALIDITY

The agreement will be considered null and void and subject to termination by default if there are no activities organized or hosted by either of the parties for three consecutive months in a calendar year from the date the MoU is signed by both the first and second parties. Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations
